Mission Statement:

Based on our belief in human potential, Goldie's Place assists adults who are homeless to become self-supporting and financially independent by providing confidence-building dental treatment, career development, job placement, and retention support.

Program Accomplishments:

Employment Program helped 100+ adults find employment for 4th year in a row

- More than doubled its Bridge Track performance contract to \$125,000 level;
- Placed 98% of Bridge Track enrollees and 65% for 3 to 6 months;
- Completed contract goals two months early;
- Contract for \$125,000 renewed for 2014 based on past performance;
- Back-to-Work Clothing Closet served over 500 people with gently used clothing for interviews and daily wear.

Dental Program reached new level of comprehensive dental treatment delivery

- Provided dental care to approximately 250 individuals over the course of 1,034 patient visits (up by 38% from 2011 baseline)
- 75 University of Illinois at Chicago - College of Dentistry students actively participate in the volunteer student run dental clinic annually
- Provided nearly \$300,000 worth of free dental services
- More than tripled the number of denture arches provided for no cost, from 16 to 51
- Continues to serve as the only free clinic providing dentures in the City of Chicago.
